# Utilities Kingston Water and Wastewater Master Plan and Pollution Prevention and Control Plan

### The Study

Utilities Kingston is undertaking a new update to their Water and Wastewater Master Plan (WWMP) and Pollution Prevention and Control Plan (PPCP) to account for future needs to 2051. The City of Kingston is expecting significant population growth over the planning horizon which has triggered the need for a combination of densification, infill, and urban boundary expansion(s). The new WMMP and PPCP will provide guidance for new and replacement infrastructure to meet existing and future needs. The study will be carried out in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association's (MEA) process for Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) Approach 1 Master Plans. The study area can be seen in Figure 1.

# **The Study Process**

The study will be carried out as a master plan in accordance with the MEA's MCEA Process (MEA 2024), which is an approved process under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. The study will follow MCEA Approach 1 for completing a master plan, which involves the preparation of the WWWMP at the end of phases 1 and 2 of the MCEA process. Results from this study will be documented in a master plan report that will be made available for public review.
